With ReWORK, customers pay TRANSDEC for the commercial office move and also for the cost of removing and warehousing any unwanted




In return ReWORK host a dedicated website for listing and promoting furniture for re-use. Once furniture has been requested and approved for donation, it is done so at no cost to the recipient.
